Chasing Horses Wild Horse Advocates (CHWHA) is continuing their fight to save the wild horses of Theodore Roosevelt National Park with a rally that will be held in Medora, ND on July 12-13, 2023,

Theodore Roosevelt National Park announced their plans to eliminate the ENTIRE herd of horses in December of 2022. CHWHA has been leading the fight to save this iconic herd of horses.

Regional Director, Herbert Frost, informed us that he will be in Medora the week of July 10<sup>th</sup>. This rally is meant to be a way for the public to voice their concerns to Director Frost and Superintendent Angie Richman about the Park's proposed plans to remove the wild horses in the south unit and the longhorn cattle in the north unit. Significant state and community members as well as experts and advocates from across the US will be speaking at this event.
